I acquired this slant window sedan about nine months ago. It was a worn out Restoration done back in the 1970s. The car had over 78,000 miles on it since restored. The top was caved in as it had been used to store heavy items. Since then, I have removed the engine and taken the body off the frame. The body has been sandblasted and repainted. I stripped all the upholstery, door latches, and window winders out. I am now installing new top bows and preparing to install the top. Meanwhile, I am rebuilding the engine and the frame needs to be powder coated. I hope to have it on the road by this summer.
